He is known as the Father of the Indian Constitution and was India's first Law Minister. He was the Chairman of the Drafting Committee for the new Constitution. He was a well-known statesman who fought for the rights of the Dalits and other socially backward classes. His birth anniversary is celebrated on 14th April every year, with great enthusiasm.
