BACKGROUND

Weeds have been recognized as a hindrance to successful crop production ever since the man started cultivation of crops. Weeds pose a greater challenge to crop production by reducing the crop yields than other pests & diseases and consume much of the farmer's time for removing them from their cultivated field. The modern day input intensive agriculture has been encountered with different weed problems with respect to changing climate & different management practices. The emerging problems in weed science needs to be properly oriented in a more scientific, efficient & economic manner so that it could fit to the needs of the farmers in allocation specific way. The most important aspects of the weed research & expertise in managing the composite weeds, parasitic, aquatic, invasive & noxious weeds in major crops and non cropped situations, endangering the crop production in general and the livelihood security of the small & marginal farmers in particular needs to be strengthened through all possible methods. Such a problematic issue "weeds" which is called as a underestimated pests needs to be addressed more particularly in tropical agriculture to develop a sound weed based and location specific management practices which will cater the needs of all the stakeholders associated with weed science & research.

Although weeds cause huge economic loss, adequate attention has not been given by farmers for effective management. The age old practice of manual weeding, which is costly, cumbersome, time and labor consuming, is still a major way of weed management in present day agriculture. An integrated approach comprising chemical, manual, mechanical and biological methods can address the emerging weed problems. A number of new, effective herbicides have been discovered

for tackling weeds in major field crops but their use in farmer's field is negligible. This can be attributed due to several factors i.e. lack of awareness among farmers, timely non availability of herbicides in market and lack of information regarding their use and technical knowhow. These problems can be addressed by bringing scientists, extension personnel, policy makers, farmers, herbicides manufacturers, distributors and different NGOs in one platform. Keeping this background in view, this seminar with a theme **"Emerging weed problems and their management in major crops"** has been planned.

The seminar will be organized with the following sub themes

- Weed problems on major crops & their management.
 - Cereals (Rice & Maize)
 - Pulses & oilseeds (Green gram, Black gram, Arhar, Ground nut, Mustard & Sesame)
 - Commercial crops (Sugar cane, cotton & Jute)
 - Vegetables (Onion & potato)
 - Weed management in different cropping systems

WHO MAY PARTICIPATE

Agronomist, research scientists, professors, lecturers, Extension scientists, officers from line departments, policy makers, administrators, herbicide manufacturers/dealers, Students/Research fellow of Agronomy, farmers and other stake holders related to weed science.

DATE AND VENUE

The seminar is scheduled to be held at Orissa University of Agriculture and Technology, Bhubaneswar, Odisha during **08-09th October, 2015.**

ABOUT BHUBANESWAR

Bhubaneswar is the capital city of Odisha state. It is well connected by train and bus from different parts of the country. It is also approachable by air from New Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, Kolkata, Hyderabad & Bangalore. The Orissa University of Agriculture and Technology is located at Surpur Square which is about 5 km away from Bhubaneswar Railway Station and the bus terminus and nearly 2 km away from the Biju Patnaik Air Port, Bhubaneswar. The second fortnight of October i.e. the time of symposium is very pleasant at Bhubaneswar. The average day temperature is 32°C and night temperature is 23°C. It should contain title, name of the authors with place of work (name of the person making presentation, along with his mailing address to be indicated as footnote), objectives of study, methodology, results, conclusion and references.
