BACKGROUND

Innovations are the drivers for growth and development. Thus, promoting innovations in agricultural research and education demands remarkable reforms in organization and management practices. NAARM has been conducting a number of workshops in education management for the benefit of senior teachers and officers of SAUs. The Executive Development Programme has been designed to sensitize senior faculty on innovations in education encompassing academic planning, teaching, academic research, and education quality. The workshop provides a platform to exchange ideas and experiences by senior functionaries for the innovation led change management in academic institutions.

OBJECTIVES

- Acquaint participants with principles and practices of innovations in agricultural education
- Building capacities in educational policy and planning
- Strategies to learn and improve quality in teaching

THEMATIC AREAS

The suggested thematic areas are: Quality improvement; University statutes, regulations and model act; Technology in education; Industry interface and internship; Autonomous colleges; Self-financing courses; Private colleges in education; Finishing schools; Entrepreneurship education; Curriculum changes; Examinations and evaluations; Experiential learning; Faculty and staff training needs; Academic research; Budget and income generations; Innovations in academics; Teaching-learning practices; Academic management and more.

PEDAGOGY

The programme will consist of blend of awareness lectures, focus discussions and experience sharing. Sessions will be organised on the suggested themes with one or two presentations followed by discussion.

ELIGIBILITY OF PARTICIPANTS

Senior Professors, Heads of Departments, Associate Deans, and university officers from agricultural universities and ICAR deemed-to-be universities.

From each university, the participants should come prepared on any thematic area and present it in the sessions. For effective coverage of all themes, interested participants are advised to contact workshop directors for further information on selection of topic, coverage and presentation details.

DURATION

The duration is four days, i.e. **January 16-19, 2013** (both inclusive). Participants shall arrive by 0900 hrs on first day and may plan to leave the Academy only after 5 p.m. on last day.

COST

Cost towards travel, lodge and board for the selected participants, limiting to one per university, shall be borne by NAARM as per NAIP/ICAR norms. The travel cost would be limited to economy class air fare by Air India (with ICAR Deal Code D095 endorsed on air tickets). ***Participants may book their tickets only after receipt of formal confirmation letter from NAARM.*** Accommodation will be provided at the Academy's guest houses.
