



## Cyber Crime Awareness Programme

The aim of organizing this type of programme is to create awareness among students, faculties and other stakeholders regarding the cybercrime and cyber fraud in this digital era. Mr. Mustakim Malek, ASI and Mr. Viren Joshi, Cyber Promoter from Cyber Cell, Anand were the speakers in this awareness programme. They gave emphasis on informing participants about various forms of cybercrime, including phishing, hacking, online fraud, malware attacks, and identity theft. They covered online shopping scams using fack e-commerce websites or listings that take payment for goods or services that are never delivered and credit card fraud using unauthorized use of a person's credit card information to make purchases or withdraw money. They also focused on precautionary measures like confidentiality of PIN, OTP, CVV, online password, etc. The expert also highlighted the Government initiatives to help citizens against cybercrime. They gave real life examples and cases related to fraud using social media, sms, apk file download, bank and insurance related frauds. At the end, they said that if any cybercrime related incidence occurred, immediately contact to nearest police station or dial 1930 toll free number without hesitation.
