India is set to impose a nation-wide ban on single-use plastic (including plastic bags, straws, cups, plates, small bottles and certain types of sachets) on October 2, 2019, on the occasion of the 150<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. India generates about 9.4 million tonnes of plastic waste each year and with no effective disposal method, the plastic waste ends up the roadsides, in landfills and water bodies.

As a part of “अमृत महोत्सव पर युवा संकल्प -श्रेष्ठ भारत के पांच प्रकल्प” and to make village plastic free, a special plastic waste free cleanliness drive and awareness rally were carried out by NSS Volunteers in Dholakuva Village on 05/03/2022.
